### Reflections Entry Categories:

#### Photography:

- \* A photography entry must be an original black-and-white or color image, or a group of images, produced by a photographic process
- \* The student must be the one to take the photograph
- \* **MUST BE MOUNTED or MATTED** on cardboard mat, poster board, or other sturdy material
- \* Must not exceed **11 x 14 INCLUDING THE MOUNTING OR MATTING**
- \* Photography entry must be also **saved as a .jpg file**

#### Dance:

- \* A Dance choreography entry must be an original choreographed dance composition
- \* Must not exceed 5 minutes and recorded on a **DVD ONLY; submit 2 DVD's saved as a .flv file**, not a DVD movie
- \* The choreographer may be the performer, one of the performers, but does not have to be
- \* Costumes are not necessary, however, if used choreographer must also create the costumes

#### Film Production:

- \* A Film entry must be an original work of fiction, non-fiction; with or without sound
- \* Can be Animation, Narrative, Documentary, Experimental, or a Media Presentation \* **NO PowerPoint presentations**
- \* Student must be the director, screenwriter, and cameraperson; and storyboarding and editing must also be done by the student
- \* Must not exceed 5 minutes and recorded on **DVD ONLY; submit 2 DVD's saved as a .flv file**, not as a DVD movie

#### Literature:

- \* A literature entries may be works of fiction or nonfiction, prose, poetry and drama
- \* Entries must not exceed 2,000 words
- \* Can be handwritten or typed (one sided only)
- \* Must be on **8 ½ x 11 paper** \* **DO NOT** mount or mat
- \* Students for whom English is not their first language may submit literature entries in their own language. **An interpretive translation in English must accompany the entry**
- \* Must **submit 1 original and 2 copies**
- \* Literature entry must also be **saved as a .pdf file if handwritten and saved as a .doc file if typed**

#### Music:

- \* A musical composition entry may be voice, instruments, or a combination of voice and instruments.
- \* Must not exceed 5 minutes and recorded on **CD ONLY; submit 2 CD's saved as a .mp3 file**, not a CD/DVD movie
- \* Middle/Junior and Senior Entries: notation, including traditional tablature or electronic is required.
- \* **Score** size shall not exceed **8 ½ x 11 paper**, also must be **saved as a .pdf file**

#### Visual Arts:

- \* A visual arts entry must be an original print, drawing, painting, collage, photographic collage, metal etching or punch work, fiber work, or computer generated
- \* **MUST BE MOUNTED OR MATTED** and not to exceed 3/8 inch in thickness
- \* Must not exceed **24 x 30 INCLUDING THE MOUNTING OR MATTING**
- \* No 3-Dimensional art work \* Laminating is discouraged
- \* Visual Arts entry must also be **saved as a .jpg file**

\*Each entry must be the original work of one student only \* Enter as many time as you want \*Enter in as many art categories as you would like \*No copyrighted material can be used \*Consent Form needed if image and/or voice of person/people can be recognized
