In 2005, a dad in a California community died from melanoma, a form of skin cancer. Only 8 weeks after being diagnosed, he was gone, leaving behind his wife, a first grade child and a pre-school child.

PTA members in the community learned that skin cancer is one of the most common forms of cancer and the most preventable; children are most at risk!

The adopted *2005 Sun Safety Resolution* was inspired by the death of one child's dad from melanoma.
