The California State PTA produces a variety of publications to keep you informed of issues affecting PTAs and our children. Each issue of *PTA in California* brings a wealth of news and information to PTA members in a twelve-page format. Each PTA president receives a copy. Five issues are printed annually with occasional special issues. Paper subscriptions to *PTA in California* are \$5.00 per year. Order additional copies for unit officers and the principal.

The Communicator

The Communicator is a subscription publication of the California State PTA. This “ready-to-use” resource contains information on leadership, health, education, parent involvement, community concerns, convention, programs, financial, communication and other information to assist you at the unit and council level. Paper subscriptions to *The Communicator* are only \$12.50 for five issues; the CD version is \$10.00 annually.



The *Sacramento Update* newsletter addresses state and federal legislation issues that affect California’s children and youth. Published five times annually, with occasional special editions, *Sacramento Update* is available in an electronic edition on the California State PTA website, capta.org, with an opt-in email notification.



PTA Connects is an online newsletter published monthly. Friendly reminders are provided along with key information for important PTA projects. It is sent out by email to all unit/council/district presidents for whom PTA has email addresses. Anyone can subscribe to *PTA Connects* at www.capta.org.



The *Communications Satellite* is published electronically five times a year and posted online on the homepage “What’s New” tab. Content includes a review of the work of each Board of Managers commission and committee, including new initiatives and more. It is e-mailed to unit/council/district presidents for whom PTA has addresses.
