

CALIFORNIA STATE PTA/STUDENT CONTRACT

In order for the coming year to be productive and safe, there are certain guidelines that student board members must follow.

Students serve as commissioners on the Board of Managers and are expected to attend all assigned meetings.

A signed (if under the age of 18) "Parent/Guardian Approval and Consent to Treatment and Emergency Contact" form must be submitted to the state office prior to the first Board of Managers meeting or activity. A "State Board Member Contact and Emergency Health Information" form (Z5) must also be on file.

The chairman of the student involvement committee will serve as liaison to the student, parent, principal, and school board.

Whenever possible, students will travel with adult member(s) of the Board of Managers from the district PTA where the student resides.

Students will check-in with the student involvement chairman upon arrival and departure of each Board of Managers meeting.

Students shall not leave the hotel without permission of the president or student involvement chairman.

Students shall not entertain guests (friends or family) in their hotel rooms without previous permission from the president or student involvement chairman.

No drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, immoral behavior or sexual misconduct will be allowed. If an infraction occurs the parents will be called and the student will be sent home. Parents will be responsible for any additional costs incurred as a result of the student's actions. In addition, a student engaging in such conduct may be removed from the Board of Managers.

Students are expected to be in their hotel room by 10 p.m. or within 30 minutes of the closing of their last meeting.

Exceptions:

- Students accompanied by adult member(s) of the Board of Managers for a social gathering.
- Students receiving prior permission from the president or student involvement chairman and accompanied by adult member(s) of the Board of Managers.

Any student driving to a meeting will adhere to the following guidelines:

- a. Vehicle use will be limited to transportation to and from the meeting.
- b. Vehicle must have current registration and be fully insured.
- c. Student must have a valid California Driver's License and be covered by the vehicle insurance.

We have read the California State PTA/Student Contract and agree with all of the guidelines. Each of us hereby releases the California State PTA and its agents from any and all liability relating to the below-named student's participation in this activity, and we further indemnify and agree to hold harmless all such released persons from any and all liability or expense they might incur by reason of such student's participation in such activity.

Situations arising that are not covered by this contract will be dealt with in a reasonable manner to ensure the continued guidance, safety and well-being of all.
